Position Title: Discipleship Pastor
Classification: Full-time, salaried position

Position Summary: The Discipleship Pastor serves as a senior leader within the church, providing vision, leadership, and oversight for the church's discipleship strategy and spiritual formation pathways.

Key Responsibilities

1. Executive Leadership

- Serve on the Executive Team alongside the Lead Pastor and Executive Pastor.
- Contribute to church-wide vision, strategy, decision-making, and organizational leadership.

- Equip leaders and volunteers to effectively disciple others.
- Help shape the church's discipleship philosophy and culture.

4. Assimilation & Congregational Integration

- Oversee pathways for new believers, new attendees, membership, and volunteer engagement.
- Partner with Care & Hospitality Pastor to help people connect meaningfully into church life.
- Develop systems that encourage spiritual growth, community involvement, and service.
- Develop systems to track new attendees for the purpose of retention and engagement.
